FROM THE CHILDREN'S ROOM



Supercrafts

This summer we had two exciting things happen!

The first was that we received a **Science is Everywhere** grant for one year starting at the end of October.

The second exciting news is that we had a **record number of children sign up for the Summer Reading Program**. Usually we print 700 reading logs and have 3 or 4 dozen logs left by the end of the summer. This summer we had to print an additional 150 logs. We had over 740 kids sign up for the program and more than the usual number of kids at the party that wrapped up the program and recognized all the children who completed their reading goals.

Another great piece of news from the summer is that we **added a part-time children's librarian** to our staff in October. This will enable us to add an additional program on Fridays and occasionally on Saturdays. Our Friday program, starting in late October, will be an additional Step into Storytime for children age 2–3. This drop-in program will run most Fridays beginning at 10 am.


