Beginning September 8, the Winchester Public Library will have new rules in place for the borrowing of materials and overdue fines. Our goal is to simplify borrowing, eliminate the high fine on overdue DVDs, and make your borrowing experience more pleasant.

The fines on both adult and children's overdue materials, including DVDs, will be twenty cents per day and the three-day grace period will remain.

All DVDs will be loaned for one week and may be renewed twice provided no one has requested the item.

### Get Started

First, if you need a library card, it's simple to get one from home; just visit <https://library.minlib.net/selfreg>.

Then visit our website (<http://www.winpublib.org/>) where all of the information below is available in detail. But if you'd like hands-on help or instruction with either the material or the technology, our reference librarians are happy to help on a drop-in basis or by appointment.

### Online Resources

Online resources are offered in two broad categories: leisure and research. Our entertainment "eLibrary" offering includes eBooks, digital magazines, music, movies, TV shows, and videos—see the listing at <http://www.winpublib.org/elibrary/>.

For online research and homework help, you can access almost 90 different resources, suitable for kindergartners to adults. The wide-ranging options include encyclopedias, newspaper archives (*Boston Globe*, *Winchester Star*, *NY Times*), and numerous specialty databases in genealogy, finance, law, history, nature, and many more subjects. # LOSE YOURSELF IN PICTORIAL MAPS

## CHASE MAPS ARE NOW DIGITIZED

Ernest Dudley Chase, 1878–1966, gained national fame creating greeting cards; artistically, though, he is perhaps most respected for his pictorial maps, 24 of which are owned by the Library and now digitally available.

As written for a Harvard exhibition, “Chase was a graphic artist who loved to populate the surface of his maps with hundreds of illustrations and ornamental features, but he strove for much more than the merely decorative. Each of these pictorial maps conveys a coherent aesthetic and thematic vision.” And his vision was wide-ranging—maps in our collection include *America the Wonderland*, *A Factual & Pictorial Map*; *World Freedom*; *Pacific Battles*; and *Stamps of America*.

## THE WINCHESTER LIBRARY TREASURE HUNT

### ASSEMBLING WINCHESTER LIBRARY'S ART AND ARTIFACTS

The Library is undertaking a significant challenge this year—compiling the description, history, and location of all our art and artifacts. And it is a most impressive collection, including historical objects, murals, sculpture, quilts, windows, etchings, maps, and portraits.

Among the collection's highlights are three Tiffany windows depicting the history of bookmaking, the mural in the main lobby "Purchase of Land from the Indians," the outdoor sculpture "Umbrella Parade" (made largely from scrap found at the Winchester

Transfer Station), and quilts made at the Jenks Center. And, of course, there's the Colonel Winchester Punch Bowl.

But this list barely touches the surface. No one publication currently lists all of our items, so assembling all this information in one place will be invaluable. To help, if you know
