

Wireless access is available on the Library's main and upper floors but signal strength varies within the building. If you find the Internet to be slow or not working from your location in the Library, move closer to the center of the building.

When you use the Internet in the Library, you are accepting the Library's Internet Access Policy that is posted in the Reference Room and on our website. Please take a moment to read it – in particular "Use of The Internet."

If you use the Minuteman databases, you will be logged in as a "Home Access" user rather than an "In Library" user so some resources may be unavailable to you on your computer.

The Library's wireless network is not secure. Information sent to and from your laptop or handheld device may be captured by anyone else with a wireless device and the appropriate software.



The Library takes no responsibility for any damage caused to your equipment from configuration changes or software downloaded while accessing the Library's public wireless network. Please update your anti-virus software before connecting to the Internet.

***We regret that librarians cannot configure your computer or handheld device for you.***

To connect to our wireless network, you will need any standard Network Interface Card installed on your laptop. You should be able to connect automatically. If you are having a problem, set your wireless **SSID** to (all lower case) **winchester**.

The following steps will help you install our network printer:

#### **For most PC operating systems (Windows XP and earlier):**

From the **Printers** folder on you laptop:

1. Click on **Add Printer**
2. Click **Next**
3. Click on **A network printer**
4. Click on **Connect to this Printer**
5. In the **Name** box type **\\print\print**
6. Click **Next**

#### **For Windows 7:**

From the Start menu:

1. Type **CMD** in the search box and **Enter**
2. At the prompt type **start\\print\print** and press **Enter**

These steps should install our network printer. If a username and password is required use **laptop** for each.

We are currently unable to provide wireless printing for PCs using Vista and for Macs.
