

Winchester Public Library Library of Things Agreement

Library of Things items can be checked out for three weeks and can be renewed twice. Library of Things items must be picked up and returned inside the Winchester Public Library at the Circulation desks. By borrowing a Library of Things Item, patrons assume full responsibility for the item. All patrons must have a signed lending agreement on file in order to check out items from the Library of Things collection. Patrons under the age of 18 need a parent or guardian to sign the agreement before checking out items. Patrons must have a MinuteMan library card in good standing to be able to check out a Library of Things collection.

By signing this agreement, I am agreeing to:

- I agree to accept full responsibility for the material while it is checked out to me.
 - I agree to return the item(s) as complete and clean as possible.
 - Items will remain checked out until all parts are accounted for.
 - I accept full financial liability for the material and accessories while in my possession.

- I agree to pay all costs (including full replacement cost) associated with damage to, loss of, or theft of the material and accessories while it is checked out to me
 - I agree to return equipment to a staff member inside the Library by the date specified at checkout.

In signing this form, I have read the Winchester Public Library's Library of Things Procedure and accept full responsibility for the material while it is checked out to me or my child. I agree to pay all costs (including the full replacement cost) associated with the damage, theft, misuse, or neglect of this item or its accessories.
